Heading into the holiday season, members of KC CASH are finalizing plans for another great tax preparation season. Beginning in the end of January, ten free tax preparation sites will open across the Greater Kansas City Region to help working families benefit from federal tax credits.

Last year, the KC CASH Coalition coordinated effort brought in \$1,658,875 Federal Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and over \$4,178,130 in Federal Refunds into the hands of low-to moderate-income members of our community.

Will you consider being a part of this large scale, and very successful effort?

There are a number of ways that you can participate. First, please consider becoming trained and volunteering as a tax preparer, greeter or translator.

Second, please consider contributing, either monetarily or in-kind to this effort. Any money or resources raised will go to address these needs:
